take part in a series of special guided tours.

On Thursday, July 1 Artsadmin curators, architects and artistic collective 'walkwalkwalk' will lead the tours, giving an inside view of the artwork and of how each piece was conceived and developed.

'walkwalkwalk' present a text-based tour from their work *Stories* from the Bethnal Green Archive, in both public and private areas of the development. Each text tells a true story from the area gathered by the group over the last five years.

Rare architecture will present the beauties of the grade II listed building, giving a fascinating insight into its history including its Victorian, Edwardian and Art Deco features and how developers have transformed the building into a modern complex.

All tours are free but have a limited capacity. The artwork tours take place hourly from 10.30am to 1.30pm.

The 'walkwalkwalk' tour is at 2.30pm and the architecture tour is at 3.30pm.
